

The most common colour system people attempt to match colours to is the print industry standard 'Pantone'. The system is commonly used by graphic designers and printers to specify colours used in corporate identities or logos and applies to inks, mixed or bought to a specific colour.

The processes involved in manufacturing Flex colours are completely different to the print industry and do not relate to the

pantone system. That being said however the below colours can provide a fair guide between our colours and the closest pantone match we can find.

We have used the Pantone Solid Coated guide as it is the most common. Colours from printers and monitors vary wildly, so please use a Pantone swatch for comparisons.
